Friends! Welcome Aboard!

Our Board of Directors has worked tirelessly to bring you a parade that will be fun and memorable for you and your unit. The parade will be a great tribute to our Service Veterans and an inspiration to our Youth. Here's how you can make this event a pleasing memory for everyone:

1. Come with the idea that you will have fun while you do your thing! Enjoy all the admiration that you will receive from the crowd! Smile, Wave and have a good time. Although military in nature, this event is a Celebration of America and her People – a party of Texans and guests.
2. In the Route map, in a North-South presentation, you will see the overall event picture. Major roadways include, at right, Highway 75 / Business I-45 and, at bottom of the map, is Highway 31 / 7th Avenue. At left is 15th St / Highway 22.
The Parade Begins and Ends at the white circle, 2nd Avenue and 13th Street. The large building to the southeast of that intersection is the Navarro County Court House. Our Parade will go south on 13th – one block and turn left on 3rd Avenue. We will go east on 3rd Avenue and turn right on Beaton St. South on Beaton to 6th Avenue – turn right. Go one block on 6th and turn right on Main St. We will go north on Main to 3rd Avenue and back to the starting point. One exception: all units that assembled in Lot 4 will continue north on Main St and exit into Lot 4.
3. Loading in the Assembly Lots is from 0830 – 0930. Please be on time. The parade line-up (moving out from the Assembly) is 0930. At 1000, the parade begins.
4. Maintain the interval between units given you by the Chief Marshal.
5. Important to remember: nothing can be tossed to the crowd. Walkers may hand things directly to people. The American Legion walkers, for example, will hand small US flags to people. You may do so as well. No candy, please.
6. A Reviewing Stand is located at 5th Avenue at Beaton. Admiral William Retz will take your salute. For military units, there is no command for “Eyes Left.” Unit commanders should salute. Civilian unit leaders and all members of your group may wave to the Admiral.
